FENCING STATE HIGHWAY 49

Fencing is complete along State Highway 49 except for parcel 33 belonging to Modella Brooks. Responsibility for fencing was determined in litigation of the District Court. Further, there is a smell number of parcels to be fenced after highway construction. Such parcels may be determined by the State Department of Highway Transportation.

IN THE MATTER OF COUNTY LAW LIBRARY

Be it remimbered that at present the County Law Library consists of only Federal Statutes, Reports, and Periodicals. The Bietrict Judge 76th Judicial District has offered to make his Law Library (State) available to the Courthouse staff and visiting attorneys.
