CONTRACT FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES

THE STATE OF TEXAS |  
COUNTY OF TITUS |

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

WHEREAS, The Commissioners Court, after having given to the County Attorney of Titus County thirty days written notice to file delinquent tax suits, and - (2) having received from him a written statement declining the request of this Court to file delinquent tax suits, for reasons therein stated, and waiving this right to the 30-day period and consenting to the Court's entering into a contract with others for the collection of delinquent taxes, without awaiting the 30-day period, and a record thereof having been made in the Minutes of the Court; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Titus County, Texas joined by the Comptroller of Public Accounts of The State of Texas, deem it necessary and expedient to contract with some competent attorney to enforce the collection of all delinquent State and county taxes for a per cent of said taxes, penalties and interest actually collected and paid to the Collector of Taxes as provided in Chapter 21, Acts of Third Called Session of the 38th Legislature, Article 7335, Revised Civil Statutes, 1925, Chapter 8, Acts of the Fourth Called Session of the 41st Legislature, Article 7335a, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes; and Chapter 229, Acts of the 42nd Legislature, Article 7264a, Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes; and
