On this the 16th day of April, 1979, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, convened in Special Session at the April term of said Court, at the Courthouse in Mt. Pleasant, Titus County, Texas, with the following members present, to-wit:

And the following order was passed by said Commissioner's Court: That the following changes be made in the existing act that created the Titus County Hospital District, to-wit:

- 1. That there shall be an elected Hospital Board composed of eleven members, which will consist of 2 members being elected from each Commissioners Precinct and 3 members Being elected County wide.
- 2. That the Hospital District shell be an independent taxing district.
- That the elected Bospital board members shall receive the sum of \$75.00 per month while duly elected providing they attend the regular scheduled monthly meetings:
- That the County Judge and Chief of the Medical Staff shall be ex-officio members of said board.
- 5. That said election of said Hospital Board shall be at the same time as the General Election.

The above order being reed, it was moved by Nr. Perr and seconded by Nr. Reynolds, that the above resolution be edopted. Motion carried.
