LEASE AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into this the 14th day of January, 1980, by and between W. C. Reynolds and Wife, June Reynolds of Titus County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "Lessor" and Bill Reynolds, Commissioner, Precinct No. 4, of Titus County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "Lessee".

By this agreement and contract, Lessor hereby agrees to lease to Lessee, and Lessee hereby agrees to lease from Lessor, upon the terms and conditions and for the consideration hereinafter stated, all of that certain land in Titus County, Texas, together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances pertaining thereto, more particularly described as follows:
