COUNTY OF TITUS I

That I, B. D. Moye, Judge of the 76th Judicial District Court, Titus County, Texas, being the only District Judge having jurisdiction in Titus County, Texas, have on this the 6th day of October, 1980, duly elected and appointed Paul E. Rogge to the office of County Auditor of said Titus County, Texas, for a term of two (2) years beginning October 6, 1980, and expiring October 5, 1982, and do hereby fix and determine the salary of such County Auditor to be Thirteen Thousand Eighteen and 20/100 Dollars (13,018.20) per annum to be paid monthly out of the General Fund of Titus County, Texas. Said Auditor shall qualify by taking the statutory oath and make the statutory bond of \$5,000.00 prior to the performance of his duties.

This order shall be duly filed and recorded in the Minutes of the 76th District Court of Titus County, Texas, and the District Clerk of Titus County, Texas, is hereby directed to furnish a certified copy of these proceedings to the Commissionere Court for their observance who shall cause the same to be recorded in its Minutes by the County Clerk of Titus County, Texas, and this order and appointment shall constitute and be authority for the payment to the said Paul E. Rogge of the salary above provided for.
