ORDER OF DISTRICT JUDGE SETTING
SALARIES FOR AUDITOR AND ASSISTANT AUDITOR

Whereas, the Honorable Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, did increase the compensation of the Tax Assessor-Collector of Titus County to \$18,540.00 annually beginning January 1, 1981.

It is, therefore, the order of the District Judge of Titus County, Texas, that the annual salary of the County Auditor, Paul E. Boggs, be increased to \$18,540.00 annually, being not more than the Tax Assessor-Collector salary, same to be effective January 1, 1981. Copies of this order shall be recorded in the Commissioners' Court Minutes of Titus County and the District Court Minutes of Titus County.
