On this the 13th day of April 1981, at a Regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, there came on for consideration the making of a contract for the collection of delinquent taxes, and motion was made by Bert B. Parr County Commissioner of Precinct No. 2, seconded by Alvin Parish, Jr. County Commissioner of Precinct No. 3, that subject to approval by the State Property Tax Board and Attorney General of Texas said Commissioners' Court in behalf said County do make and enter into a contract with Jack McCreary a licensed attorney, for the letter to collect delinquent taxes in said County for 15% of the amount of taxes, penalty and interest collected, said contract to end on the 31st day of December 1982 with six months thereafter to complete pending suits, requiring said attorney to give bond in the sum of \$250.00, and to be on the forms currently promulgated and recommended by the State Property Tax Board.
