THE STATE OF TEXAS I
COUNTY OF TITUS I

BE IT REMEMBERED that the Commissioners Court of Titus County met in Regular Session on November 9th, 1981, after notice of the meeting had been posted in the form, manner and place required by law, with a quorum of its members present and participating in the meeting. When among other matters, the following came on to be considered and action taken thereon, to-wit:

Came on to be considered the application of TEXAS UTILITIES GENERATING COMPANY, to close the remaining segments of certain county roads lying south of Interstate Highway 30 in Titus County, Texas, more fully described as:

(1) On the first road running east from the Country road that runs south from Winfield to Monticello, it is proposed to close said east road from its junction with the said Winfield-Monticello road east to a point situated at the SE corner of a 25 acre tract out of a 58.25 acre tract in the J. NEWMAN SURVEY, A-412 (being the point at which another portion of road was previously discontinued and abandoned by order of this Commissioners Court).

(2) That portion of the County road northwest of the intersection of the existing County road with the most easterly end of a new road built by TUGCO and heretofore accepted by this Commissioners Court which portion to be closed begins at the NW corner of a certain one acre tract in the JOHN GREENWOOD SURVEY, A-238, heretofore conveyed to Jim Ranes and Olyn Press by deed recorded in Vol. 421, p. 49, Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, and proceeding in a Northwesterly direction to the point where this road was previously discontinued and abandoned by this Commissioners Court at its intersection with the so-called Walker road then in a southerly direction along the so-called Walker road to a point where said Walker road was previously closed by order of this Commissioners Court.

After considerations of said application, the following Motion was made by Commissioner Bert Parr, Seconded by Commissioner Bill Reynolds, to-wit:

The described road in item (1) above is discontinued and abandoned from its junction with the said Winfield-Monticello road east to a point situated at the SE Corner of a 25 acre tract out of a 58.25 acre tract in the J. NEWMAN SURVEY, A-412.

The described road in item (2) above is discontinued and abandoned from the NW corner of a certain one acre tract in the JOHN GREENWOOD SURVEY, A-238, heretofore conveyed to Jim Ranes and Olyn Press by deed recorded in Vol. 421, p. 49 Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, and proceeding in a Northwesterly direction to the point where this road was previously discontinued and abandoned by this Commissioners Court at its intersection with the so-called Walker road to the point where said Walker road was previously closed by order of this Commissioners Court.

The applicant may proceed to place appropriate barricades on the discontinued road.

Upon a vote, all voted "aye", and none voted "no", and the County Judge declared the Motion carried.
