A "Claims Made" policy provides coverage to you for any claim made against you as a County or Individual or group of individuals, provided the claim is made during the policy period and a wrongful act happens during the policy period or prior to the policy period, if you have not given notice to a prior carrier and you had no knowledge of the wrongful act, error or ommissions likely to give rise to a claim. The policy also provides defense for any suit where the alleqations would indicate a wrongful act. There will be no further coverage once the aggregate limits are exhausted. There are ten (10) exclusions. The previous purposes of the exclusions are to exclude criminal acts and avoid duplicate coverage as provided by other policies. The conditions of the policy are pretty standard except it does have a thirty (30) day cancellation clause instead of the usual ten (10) days. I have tried to cover the highlights of the coverage.
