IN THE MATTER OF
CHAIR FOR COURT REPORTER

Motion was made by Commissioner Thomas to buy the \$180.00 chair from Quill for the court reporter. Commissioner Logan seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ronnie Logan and seconded by Commissioner James Thomas that Judge Harper and Commissioner Loyd Clark work on new Christmas decorations for the courthouse. Motion carried unanimously.
