LLOYD E. BILLUPS, SALARY RAISE

WHEREAS, the Official Court Reporter of the 76th Judicial District of Texas, Lloyd E. Billups is presently drawing a salary of \$22,151.76 per year (\$1,845.98 per month) apportioned among the three counties of the District, and,

WHEREAS, due to inflation in the cost of living, and in order to conform his salary to that of Official Court Reporters serving a similar population and with a like work load, the Court deems it necessary and appropriate that the salary should be increased \$184.59 a month or an increase of \$2,215.12 per year, making a salary of \$24,366.88 per year, or \$2,030.57 per month, commencing on October 1, 1984, and to be apportioned among the three counties on a per monthly basis as follows:

CAMP COUNTY.....	\$451.24
MORRIS COUNTY.....	\$676.86
TITUS COUNTY.....	\$902.47

This order is entered pursuant to and in conformity with the provisions of Article 3912K Section 3 Vernon's Annotated Statutes of the State of Texas, this 18 July, 1983.
