RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION OF THE TITUS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT CREATING AN ALMINISTRATIVE BOARD TO ADMINISTER THE TITUS COUNTY PARK.

WHEREAS, the Titus County Park is a beautiful and valuable facility for recreation purposes, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Commissioners' Court of Titus County that the Titus County Park be administered in the best possible manner as a place of clean and wholesome recreation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION I:

The Commissioners' Court of Titus County hereby creates the Titus County Park Administrative Board, hereinafter referred to as The Board.

SECTION II:

The Board shall consist of three members, two of which shall be appointed by the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, hereinafter referred to as The Court.

SECTION III:

Since the Titus County Park, hereinafter referred to as The Park, is located in Commissioner Precinct #2, the Commissioner for Precinct #2 shall be a member of The Board.

ECTION IV

The other two members of The Board shall be appointed for a term of two years except one of the two persons first appointed to The Board shall be appointed to a term which expires December 31, 1987. The term of the other first appointed member of The Board shall expire December 31, 1988. Any member of The Board whose term expires may be reappointed by The Court.

SECTION V:

The members of the Board shall conduct meetings at such time, place and manner as they shall consider proper and will receive no compensation for their service.

SECTION VI:

The Board shall have authority to manage, operate, maintain, equip as well as manage the fiscal affairs of The Park.

SECTION VII.

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The Roard shall have authority to pass and enforce reasonable rules and regulations affecting visitors to the Park.

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SECTION VIII,

The Board shall have authority to accept, receive and expend gifts of money or other valuable things which may be given to The Park.

SECTION IX:

The Board shall keep a true and full record of its meetings and proceedings and preserve these and all other records until such time as they may be delivered to The Court for safe keeping.

SECTION X:

Any action taken by The Board does not become final until approved by The Court.

SECTION XI;

The funds belonging to The Park shall continue to be deposited and disbursed through the office of the County Treasurer and County Auditor as they have been in the past.

SECTION XII:

It is the desire of The Court that The Park he operated as a place for all visitors to enjoy. To do this it is necessary that all laws, rules and regulations he observed, A copy of this Resolution shall be delivered to law enforcement officials and parks personnel as a request that they give necessary attention to assure that law and order will be maintained at all times.
