RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County met in regular session March 9, 1987 with all members present and with unanimous vote of the court approved joint election for April 4, 1987 with the Titus County Hospital Board; and

MHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Titus County called an election for April 4, 1987 for the purpose of allowing the voters of Titus County to vote on the proposition of a 1/2 of 1% sales tax to help lower property taxes, and Titus County Hospital Board called an election for board members for April 4, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the following agreement was reached: The twenty (20) voting precincts plus absentee will be used for the April 4, 1987 joint election. The county and the hospital board will each have their own supplies and voting boxes. The largest precincts (11) will have four workers and the smallest precincts (10) will have three workers. The election judges are: Box 1, Leo Mosley; Box 2, Betty Hill; Box 3, Josephine Mankin; Box 4, Bessie Porter; Box 5, Alvin Blalock; Box 6, Billie Ann Morris; Box 7, Willard Cecil; Box 8, Tane Kidwell; Box 9, Mary Welch; Box 10, Marie Brown; Box 11, Joyce Eubanks; Box 12, Roy V. Hensley; Box 13, Don Martin; Box 14, Charlie Blalock; Box 15, Harry Culver; Box 16, Ray Fortner; Box 17, Box Winsett; Box 18, Mataline Broach; Box 19, Haskell Peek; Box 20, J. Travis Jackson; Box 21, absentee, Rose Myers. Pay for the election judges will be \$55.00 for the day plus \$25.00 for delivering the boxes to the hospital board. Pay for the other workers will be \$55.00 for the day, with exception of one worker (not the judge) to deliver the boxes from each voting box. This worker from each voting box will be paid an extra \$25.00 for delivering boxes to the county. Titus County and the hospital board will divide the cost of paying the election workers evenly.
