

In Re Application of Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America, a Corporation, for Permission and Authority to Locate, Construct, Operate, and Maintain a Gas Pipeline Under and Across the Roads and Highways of the County of Titus, State of Texas

NOW CONES Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America, a Corporation, and respectfully makes application to this Honorable Board to grant unto said applicant the right, permission, and authority to use, cross and occupy the roads and highways of the County of Titus, and State of Texas, along the proposed route of a gas pipeline substantially as shown on the plat which is marked "Exhibit A", and which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, for the purpose of locating, constructing, using, operating, maintaining and finally removing therefrom a 30" inch gas pipeline under and across the designated roads and highways, in said County, for use in the transportation of natural gas in the County and State aforesaid.

Applicant represents unto this Honorable Board that it owns and operates a gas pipeline system extending Northeasterly from the State of Texas to the State of Illinois; that it contemplates the construction in the near future of an addition and extension to its said gas pipeline system; that said extension when constructed, will be an integral part of applicant's gas transportation system; that applicant has secured or will secure a certificate of public convenience and necessity for such construction from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission; and that it will be necessary in laying its said line to cross under County and public roads and highways as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto.

Applicant further represents that it will comply with all written rules and regulations of appropriate regulatory authorities with respect to the construction of said gas pipeline under and across said designated roads and highways in said County; and that it will furnish the office of the County Engineer notice of intention to construct said pipeline under and across said roads and highways in said County at least 48 hours prior to beginning any construction work thereon.

Applicant further represents that it will so construct the proposed gas pipeline that the construction of the same will interfere as little as possible with public travel on said roads and highways; and that it will be responsible for all damages resulting from locating, constructing, using, operating, maintaining, and finally removing said gas pipeline; that all work of crossing the County and public roads and highways shall be done under the supervision of competent engineers employed by applicant; and that the general manner of the construction of such highway crossings as are reflected hereby set forth in attached "Exhibit B", an engineering drawing showing a typical pipeline crossing of a County highway, which is herein incorporated by reference hereto. Except where prevented by reason of terrain, weather, or particular location conditions, construction of the pipeline crossings requested hereby will be as shown on Exhibit B.

Applicant further represents that it will undertake crossings of said designated roads and highways in a careful and workmanlike manner and in the event damage is done to any of the said roads and highways by the laying of said pipeline, applicant shall at its own expense repair such damage as expeditiously as possible.

WHEREFORE, the said applicant prays this Honorable Board to make and pass an order herein, authorizing and permitting this applicant to locate, construct, use, operate, and maintain, and finally remove the gas pipeline under and across the roads and highways in the County and State aforesaid, along the proposed route of said gas pipeline substantially as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

It appearing from said application that it would be appropriate and beneficial to the public, and  
to said applicant, to grant the permission and authority requested; and

It appearing that the said applicant will construct said proposed gas pipeline in such a manner  
that the construction of the same will not interfere with public travel, and will abide by the written rules  
and regulations of the appropriate officials of the County and State aforesaid respecting such construc-  
tion.

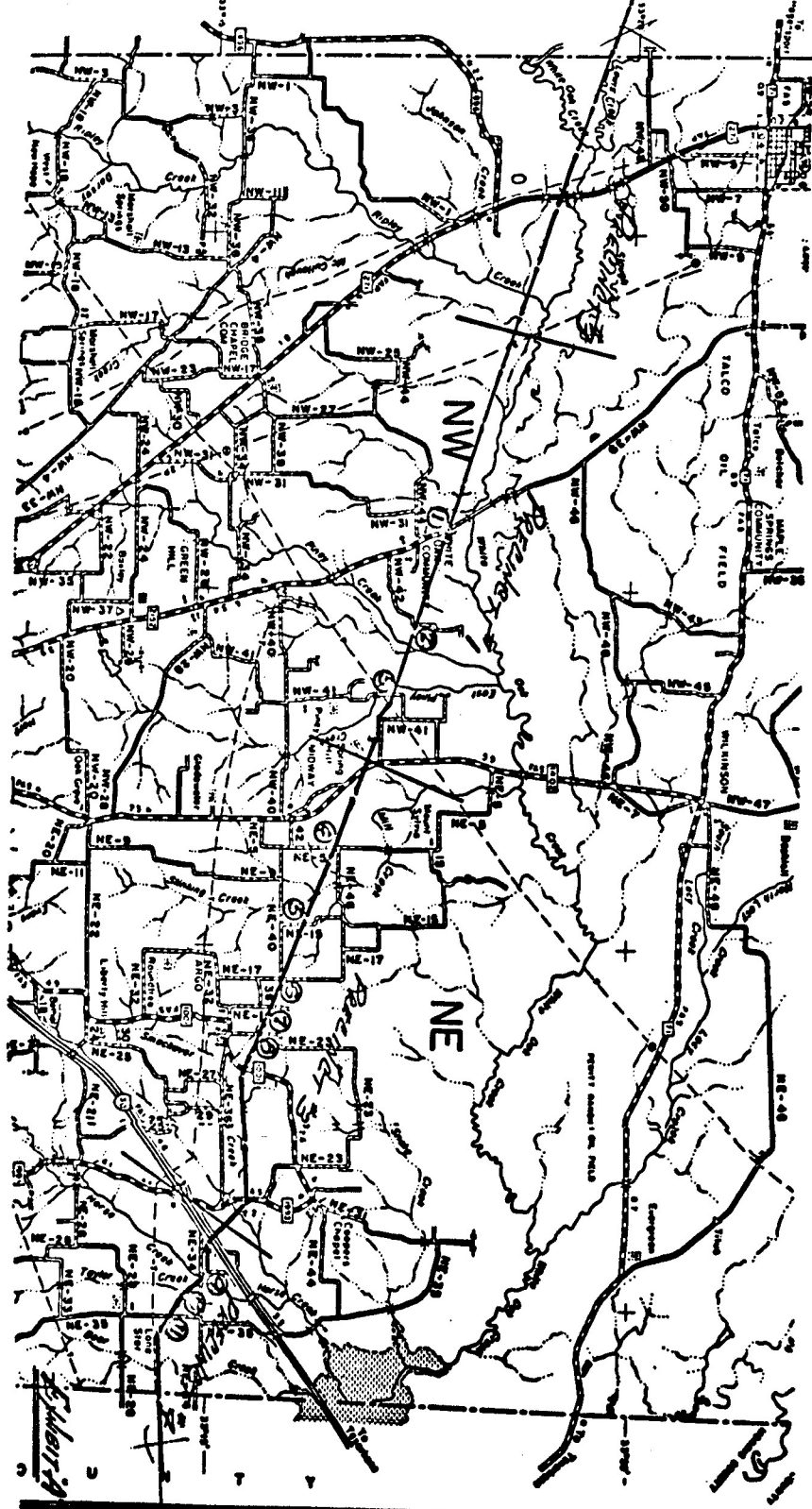
THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND DETERMINED that NATURAL GAS PIPELINE  
COMPANY OF AMERICA, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, be and it is hereby authorized and  
empowered to use, cross and occupy the roads and highways along the proposed route of said gas pipe-  
line substantially as designated on the Plat attached to and made a part of applicant's application as  
Exhibit A thereof, to which reference is made with greater particularity, for the purpose of locating,  
constructing, using, operating, and maintaining thereunder, and finally removing therefrom a gas pipeline  
under and across said roads and highways.

It is further ORDERED that in the construction of said pipeline said applicant will comply with  
applicable regulations and laws of this County and State; that the use by the public of said roads and  
highways will be interfered with as little as possible, and that in the exercise of the rights granted here-  
under, applicant shall adhere to the terms and conditions set forth in its application for said rights, and  
shall be responsible for all damages arising from the locating, constructing, using, operating, and main-  
taining, and finally removing said gas pipeline.

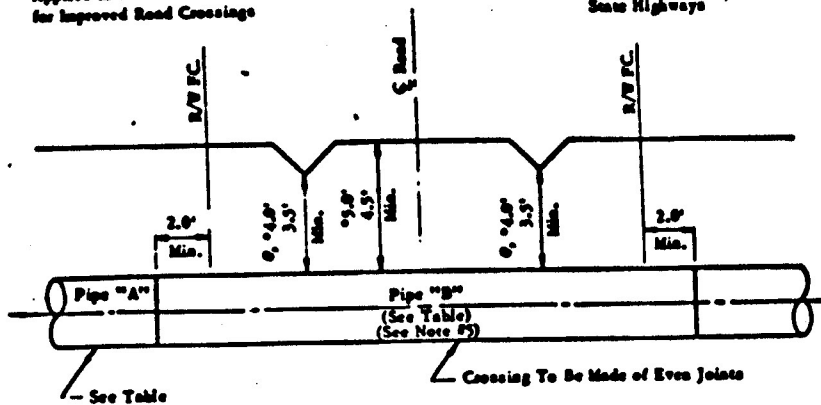

## NOTE:

1. This type of crossing to be made at all public roads where casing is not specified.  
No change of pipe will be made at crossings of private roads unless specifically requested.
2. Pipe length shown above is minimum required by code.
3. Within uncovered portion of unimproved roadways, all open cut crossings to be backfilled with sand topped with one foot of crushed rock.

## NOTE:

4. Improved road crossings shall be bored.
5. Oklahoma State Highway crossing shall be made with pipe at least one grade better or one nominal wall thickness greater than the line pipe.
