\section*{Gentlemen:}

Texas Utilities Mining Company (TUMCO) would show that it has coal and lignite leases on several thousand acres of land lying in the southwestern and northern parts of Titus County, Texas. In order to effectively carry out its mining program, it will be necessary that certain segments of county roads located within TUMCO's proposed mining area be closed, abandoned and vacated. Pursuant to authority vested in the Commissioners' Court under Articles 2351(2) and 6702-1, Sec. 2.002, V.A.T.S., TUMCO respectfully requests the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, to close, abandon and vacate the following described segments of county roads located in Titus County, Texas, identified in items (1) through (7) below:
(1) TUMCO requests the closure, abandonment and vacation of a segment of a county road, identified as County Road SW-22, beginning at the northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to TUMCO by Barbara Beth Joyner, as recorded in Vol. 718, Page 161, of the Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, extending south approximately 0.2 miles to its end, said segment being marked as Road \#1 on the map attached hereto as Attachment 1;
(2) TUMCO requests the closure, abandonment and vacation of a segment of a county road, identified as County Road NW-12, beginning at the southwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to TUMCO by W. N. Rieger et ux, as recorded in Vol. 694, Page 189, of the Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, continuing north approximately 0.3 mile, then east approximately 0.6 mile to the intersection of County Roads NW-12 and NW-4, said segment being marked as Road \(\# 2\) on the map attached hereto as Attachment 2;
(3) TUMCO requests the closure, abandonment and vacation of a segment of a county road, identified as County Road NW-24, beginning at the southwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to TUMCO by Vennie Rea Penny, as recorded in Vol. 781, Page 141, of the Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, continuing in an easterly direction along NW-24 approximately 1.8 miles to the intersection of County Road NW-24 and Farm-to-Market Highway 2152, said segment being marked as Road \#3 on the map attached hereto as Attachment 3;
(4) TUMCO requests the closure, abandonment and vacation of a segment of a county road, identified as County Road NW-35, beginning at the northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to TUMCO by Earnest L. McAnally et ux, as recorded in Vol. 540, Page 148, of the Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, continuing in a southerly direction along NW-35 approximately 1.0 mile to the intersection of County Road NW-35 and Loop 419, said segment being marked as Road \(\# 4\) on the map attached hereto as Attachment 4 ;
(5) TUMCO requests the closure, abandonment and vacation of a segment of a county road, identified as County Road NW-35A, beginning at the northeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to TUMCO by Jack Stephens et ux, as recorded in Vol. 651, Page 120, of the Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, extending west approximately 0.3 mile to the intersection of County Road NW-35 and U.S. Highway 271, said segment being marked as Road \#5 on the map attached hereto as Attachment 4;
(6) TUMCO requests the closure, abandonment and vacation of a segment of a county road, identified as County Road NW-35B, beginning at the northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to TUMCO by James Gerald Chance et ux as recorded in Vol. 586, Page 201, of the Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, extending east approximately 0.7 mile to its end, said segment being marked as Road \#6 on the map attached hereto as Attachment 4; and
(7) TUMCO requests the closure, abandonment and vacation of a segment of a county road, identified as County Road NW-37, beginning at the northwest corner of a tract of land conveyed to TUMCO by Robert K. Moran et ux, as recorded in Vol. 523, Page 387, of the Deed Records of Titus County, Texas, extending south approximately 0.9 mile, then east approximately 0.4 mile to the intersection of NW-37 and Farm-To-Market Highway 2152, said segment being marked as Road \(\# 7\) on the map attached hereto as Attachment 4.

TUMCO requests that the Commissioners' Court of Titus County, Texas, adopt and enter an order which closes, abandons and vacates the segments of county roads identified in items (1) through (7), above.

In the event that there are individuals living on lands in the vicinity of the roads for which closure, abandonment and vacation is being requested, no such resident or landowner will be denied access to their property. TUMCO would further show that they own the lands located on both sides of the segments of county roads sought to closed, abandoned and vacated.

Contingent upon the approval of the aforementioned road closures, TUMCO proposes that within one year after all mining has been completed in the road closing areas, they will construct two separate new road segments with a typical section as shown on Attachment 5 . A general description of the new road segments is as follows:
(a) The first new road segment is proposed for construction beginning generally at a point along NW-12 and adjacent to Damascus Church, and being the same point as located approximately 0.4 mile northerly along \(N W-12\) as measured from the intersection of NW-12 and Farm-To-Market Highway 1734. The proposed new road segment shall then extend to the north northeast to the intersection of NW-12 and NW-4;
(b) The second new road segment is proposed for construction beginning at a point along the eastern right-of-way of U.S. Highway 271 or Loop 419, and being a point along said right-of-way between the intersection of Loop 419 and NW-12 to the south, and the intersection of U.S. Highway 271 and NW-24 to the north. The proposed new road segment shall then extend to the north northeast to the western right-of-way of Farm-To-Highway 2152.

All mining should be completed in the vicinity of the first new road segment by the end of 2000 and by the end of 2008 in the vicinity of the second new road segment. These completion dates are approximate and could be changed due to a change in the mining plans, stripping conditions, and lignite demand.

The roads sought to be closed, abandoned and vacated have not been classified by the Commissioners' Court, and TUMCO would represent that the public interest will be better served by closing, abandoning and vacating the segments of the roads in question in order that the area may be mined and that the coal and lignite lying in, on and under such segments of county roads and the surrounding area may be removed.
