County Judge Danny P. Crooks stated, "The Senior Citizen's Meal Center had to close for lack of funds. The center had been operating on a three day work schedule temporary." Judge Crooks said, "It is the hopes of this Court that the City will come in on this project since the citizens of Mt. Pleasant will benefit as well as county residents."

Commissioner Mike Fields stated, "We have been working the last three weeks on trying to solve the problem on reopening and continue keeping the center open." Fields said, "It is important not only for the nutritional value but the fellowship it provides our senior citizens. The center is receiving no federal assistance at this time." Commissioner Fields praised the senior citizens for the outstanding job preparing this county and we are blessed

because of it. The Meals On Wheels have continued to operate during this period, Commissioner Fields remarked.

Commissioner Mike Price said, "Commissioner Hockaday is absent because of an out of town doctors appointment however he is with us on this matter."

Commissioner Fields added that he had received calls from some churches wanting to help with the funding to see the center opened again.

Motion was made by Commissioner J. W. Terrell, Jr. and seconded by Commissioner Mike Price to approve the estimate cost of the Senior Citizens Meal Center with the expectation of the City helping with the cost. Motion carried unanimously. *SEE ATTACHMENT "A"*

County Judge Danny P. Crooks asked, "Jo Mars since you are a member of the City Council do you feel the City will be willing to help?"

Councilwoman Mars replied, "I am not here representing the City. However, I am here as a concerned citizen wanting to see the Senior Citizens Meal Center reopened and operating from now on. I surely will talk to the other members of the council for this project."

Motion was made by Commissioner J. W. Terrell, Jr. and seconded by Commissioner Mike Price to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
