RESOLUTION

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT THE TITUS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT met in Special Session March 22, 1999, and approved Resolutions for the 1999 tax year; and

 $\mathcal{R}ESOCVED$ to allow a discount to the property owners of Titus County for the early payment of property taxes for the 1999 tax year in accordance with Section 31.05 of the Property Tax Code. The rate of discount is 3% if paid in the month of October, 1999; 2% if paid in November 1999; 1% if paid in December, 1999;

RESOCVED to allow a 20% exemption on the value of homesteads in Titus County for purposes of county property tax for the tax year 1999, in accordance with Section 11.13, but not less than \$5000.00.

 ${\cal R}ESOCVED$ that the Property Tax Code permits an exemption of an additional amount on all homesteads in Titus County owned by persons 65 years of age or older in determining the amount of property tax due for the 1999 tax year, in accordance with Section 11.13. This amount has been \$15,000.00.

RESOCVED that persons under age 65 who are 100% disabled, according to Social Security records, are hereby granted an additional exemption of \$10,000. on their homestead for the tax year 1999, in accordance with 11.13 D.

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF ______ COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the Texas Legislature is presently in session and among the many other bills being considered is S.B. 728 which would amend Chapter 442 of the Texas Government Code and provide for the creation of a Historic Courthouse Preservation Program; and

WHEREAS, the restoration and preservation of the historic courthouses within the State of Texas is a necessary and essential undertaking if the citizens of Texas hope to preserve the historical heritage of our state; and

WHEREAS, it is financially necessary that the State of Texas establish a historic courthouse preservation program as the cost incumbent upon local counties would far exceed their present abilities to adequately and property preserve such important structures; NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Commissioners Court of <u>TITUS</u> County, Texas that we encourage the Texas Legislature to pass into law S.B. 728 and thereby amend Chapter 442 of the Texas Government Code to establish a Historic Courthouse Preservation Program for the State of Texas; and we do further urge the Texas Legislature to fund such Historic Courthouse Preservation Program in an amount of not less than \$200 million so as to adequately provide the resources necessary for this undertaking.
