## IN THE MATTER OF DISCUSSING AND APPROVING DRY HYDRANTS FOR TITUS COUNTY

Mr. Kirthell Roberts spoke to the Court regarding placing dry hydrants throughout Titus County. Mr. Roberts said, "We have already dry-hydrants installed in Cass County, Camp County, and Morris County. My company has helped with the labor to install the hydrants as well as tech support. We are in hopes of pressing the state offices to mandate lower resident insurance once the hydrants are installed throughout the state."

Forester Doyce Winchester stated, "The State has a Two Hundred Thousand Dollar Grant for the purchase of dry hydrants. I would like to suggest the County purchase 30 dry-hydrants to be spread across the county. The cost would be approximate $\$ 15,000.00$. Titus County could recover the total cost by submitting the proper request forms to the State Office. The City of Mt. Pleasant has already purchased 12 dry hydrants. That would give a total of 42 dry hydrants in Titus County. You could go back and purchase more at a later date. We plan to speak with the newspaper if you approve this purchase. They could place an article advising the rural property owners of your decision and the necessary clarifications to be considered for placement of a dry hydrant on their property."

Commissioner Thomas E. Hockaday asked, "If we have another year of drought what effect would that have on the pond being used for a dry hydrant?"

Mr. Roberts replied, "Our study for a site depends on a 50 year drought plan. The pond considered for use as a dry hydrant must meet those specifications or others to clarify."

Motion was made by Commissioner Mike Price and seconded by Commissioner Thomas E. Hockaday to approve the purchase of 30 dry hydrants at the cost of $\$ 15,000.00$. Motion carried unanimously.
