STANDING RULES AND ORDERS OF THE 76<sup>TH</sup> AND 276<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURTS FOR THE GROUP HEALTH AND/OR DENTAL GROUP INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR THE OFFICIAL COURT REPORTERS FOR SAID COURTS

Effective Date -- January 1, 2002

Whereas the official court reporters of the 76<sup>th</sup> and 276<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Courts are as a matter of law full time employees of each of the counties comprising the respective judicial district for which they work, and as such are entitled to the same retirement and insurance benefits as are provided to other county employees;

And, Whereas said official court reporters have heretofore been enrolled in various county insurance programs without any standing rules or orders to determine which county should provide such benefits to which reporter which situation has led to dissension and confusion;

Be it remembered that on this date the below signed District Judges in and for the 76<sup>th</sup> and 276<sup>th</sup> Judicial Courts hereby adopt, order, establish and order published these rules and orders for the enrollment and coverage of the official court reporters of said courts in a group insurance plan offered county employees within the appropriate district.

I.

The official courts reporters of the 76<sup>th</sup> and 276<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Courts shall, upon their election, be enrolled in the group insurance program that is offered county employees in their "home county". By "home county" is meant the county in which the court reporter in question actually resides if such county is a county within the judicial district of the court which employs such court reporter. If the court reporter in question lives outside any county of the judicial district by which he is employed, then "home county" means the county which the District Judge who has employed and appointed the court reporter in question has declared as the judge's home county to the Office of the Comptroller for the State of Texas.

The costs incurred by the "home county" to provide a group insurance program and any other similar or related benefits to the official Court Reporter for the 276<sup>th</sup>

Judicial District Court shall be apportioned pro rata among the four counties comprising the 276<sup>th</sup>

Judicial District on a per month basis as follows:




