**COMMISSIONERS COURT OF TITUS COUNTY
SPECIAL MEETING
MAY 22, 2007**

Judge Sam Russell called the Special meeting to order stating that for the record, notice of the meeting was posted 72 hours prior to today's meeting according to the Open Meetings Act and that the purpose of today's meeting was to canvass votes for the May 12, 2007 Constitutional Amendment election.

Judge Russell turned the meeting over to Elections Administrator, Leonard Rockwell who stated that this meeting is requested by the State in order to review the summary of votes.

Mr. Rockwell presented handouts showing the total summary of Precinct returns, early voting and breakdown of Precinct returns.

Commissioner Phillip Hinton made a motion and was seconded by Commissioner Bob Fitch to accept the figures presented by Elections Administrator. Motion carried unanimously.

Judge Russell told the Commissioners' Court that forms for the Cash Jury Fund would be ready for the Commissioners to look at this afternoon.

Commissioner Mike Fitch stated that he had checked on the bill with the State Legislature which would allow the fire departments to assist each other within the State without having to have a Mutual Aid Agreement. He will check next week after the Senate meets and see what the outcome is.

Teresa Price, County Clerk, asked that the Commissioners' Court look into the matter of using credit card for acceptance of payments. She will get with the company and schedule a workshop.

The roof is still leaking and needs to be checked. Judge Russell stated that the money is in the budget.

Motion was made by Commissioner Phillip Hinton and seconded by Commissioner Bob Fitch to adjourn. Motion carried.
