1. Consider the canvass of votes for the constitutional amendment election held on November 6, 2007


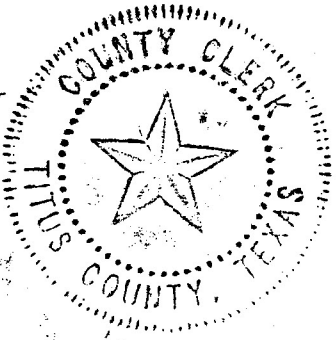
