

Judge Sam Russell called the Special Meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. on November 26, 2007 noting that for the record, notices were posted for the appropriate amount of time at places readily accessible to the general public at all times and remained posted for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.

Judge Sam Russell led the Commissioners' Court in the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioner Mike Fields gave the invocation.

**1. Public comments and/or requests for information on non-agenda items in accordance with Section 551.042, Texas Open Meetings Act**

There were no public comments.

**2. Consider and possibly approve minutes for November 13 and November 16, 2007**

Motion was made by Commissioner Bob Fitch and seconded by Commissioner Phillip Hinton to approve minutes for November 13 and November 16, 2007. Motion carried unanimously.

**3. Consider and possibly approve 2008 Titus County Holidays**

Motion was made by Commissioner Mike Fields and seconded by Commissioner Bob Fitch to approve the 2008 Titus County Holidays. Motion carried unanimously.

**4. Consider and possibly approve the 2008 schedule of meetings for Commissioners' Court**

Judge Russell informed the Court that Commissioners' Court meetings are held the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month except when this falls on a Holiday. Commissioner Mike Fields stated that the Annual Judges & Commissioners Continuing Education Conference was held at College Station the week of February 11, 2008 and would like to change the Commissioners' Court meeting scheduled on Monday, February 11<sup>th</sup> to Friday, February 8, 2008. Motion was made by Commissioner Mike Fields and seconded by Commissioner Phillip Hinton to approve the 2008 schedule of meetings for Commissioners' Court as presented with the exception of changing Monday, February 11, 2008 to Friday, February 8, 2008. Motion carried unanimously.

## **5. Consider and possibly approve Renewal of Medical Plan**

Gail Norris from HealthFirst informed the court that there were three (3) different parts of the insurance that needed to be determined during today's Commissioners' Court Meeting: medical carrier, network and benefits/premiums.

Ms. Norris first presented the court with the 2008 Employee Benefit Renewal Proposal with a recommendation that the court consider changing carriers to Alliance – American National due to lower cost in premiums with no change in service. They have waived personal health and no benefits will be sacrificed in going with this carrier. Ms. Norris stated that they only send bid packets to A+/A- carriers. New ID cards will have to be issued to all employees. Ms. Norris was asked to explain what Specific Deductible (\$45,000) and Aggregating Specific (\$45,000) meant. She stated that the specific deductible is what the county is out on a person. An additional \$40,000 (aggregating specific) will be paid by the County if needed. Motion was made by Commissioner Thomas Hockaday and seconded by Commissioner Phillip Hinton to go with Alliance – American National with the \$45,000/\$40,000 specific and aggregating deductibles. Motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Norris addressed the second issue of Network coverage for Titus County. Titus County now has Healthcare Partners of East Texas. Ms. Norris recommended going with Access Direct, wrapping this with Access Direct Platinum and then with PHCS network. Access Direct will pick up Titus Regional Medical Center (TRMC) and local physicians; Access Direct Platinum covers a smaller area with bigger discounts and PHCS is nationwide and would cover employees when they are on vacation or even when they are out of the country. If out of the country, the employee would have to pay the medical expenses and turn in receipts once they are back for reimbursement. Access Direct Platinum includes East Texas Medical Center Hospitals (ETMC) and the Tyler area. She stated that East Texas Medical Center gives a larger discount than other hospitals and could be found in Wood County, Pittsburg and Tyler. Judge Russell stated that he felt that the court would be advocating using ETMC opposed to TRMC. Ms. Norris answered back in that this was not what they were trying to do but simply giving the employee another option and this was another way to save taxpayer money. Motion was made by Commissioner Phillip Hinton and seconded by Commissioner Mike Fields to accept the proposal to use Access Direct and wrap with Access Direct Platinum and PHCS. Motion carried unanimously.

The third issue regarded whether to change the amount of deductibles, out-of-pocket expenses and dependent premiums. The annual out-of-pocket maximum is now \$2000 with \$600 deductible and the out-of-network is \$4000 annual out-of-pocket with \$1000 deductible. Carl Johnson, County Auditor, recommended increasing premiums for dependent coverage by \$10 per dependent. Judge Russell stated that this would cause a hardship on those who make a lower salary such as \$9.00/hour opposed to those who make a higher salary such as elected officials and that this would take most, if not all, of the 5% salary increase the employees received. Arvel Shepard, County Sheriff, agreed with Judge Russell stating that he had several employees who had 3-4 dependents and this would make a big difference in their paychecks. Commissioner Bob Fitch stated the County has good insurance but that the employees needed

to pick up part of the burden of cost even though he hated to impose additional cost on them. Motion was made by Commissioner Bob Fitch and seconded by Commissioner Thomas Hockaday to leave insurance benefits as they are and to raise dependent premiums \$10.00 per month per dependent. Motion carried. Note that Judge Russell opposed.

Carl Johnson presented the present Cobra rates indicating that they had decreased since 2005. Ms. Norris did not agree with this and asked the court to allow her to check her files before any action is taken. Motion was made by Commissioner Bob Fitch and seconded by Commissioner Phillip Hinton to table the matter regarding setting Cobra premiums until the next Commissioners' Court meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Ms. Norris informed the Court that she would be here on January 3, 2008 to meet with the employees to go over insurance changes and any questions they might have regarding insurance. The meetings will be held at 9:30 and 10:45 a.m. in the Commissioners' Courtroom.

Motion was made by Commissioner Thomas Hockaday and seconded by Commissioner Phillip Hinton to approve Plat of Latson Heights Addition Lot 14W-R & Lot 14E-R, Block 6. Motion carried unanimously.

**9. Consider and possibly approve Jewel D. Lee as Deputy Sheriff**

Motion was made by Commissioner Bob Fitch and seconded by Commissioner Mike Fields to approve Jewel D. Lee as Deputy Sheriff. Motion carried unanimously.

**10. Consider and possibly approve Resolution of Votes Cast to Elect Directors for Titus County Appraisal District for the Year 2008-2009**

Judge Russell informed the court that Titus County had 906 votes to cast. These could all be used on one person or divided. Motion was made by Commissioner Mike Fields and seconded



by Commissioner Phillip Hinton to approve Resolution of Votes Cast to Elect Directors for Titus County Appraisal District for the Year 2008-2009 and to divide 906 votes 5 ways between Randy Beckett; Alford Flanagan; Gerald Hampton; Ezeal McGill and Charles Wright. Motion carried unanimously.

**11. Consider and possibly approve appointment of Jennifer Arnold to Titus County Child Welfare Board**

Motion was made by Commissioner Thomas Hockaday and seconded by Commissioner Bob Fitch to approve Jennifer Arnold to the Titus County Child Welfare Board. Motion carried unanimously.

**12. Consider and possibly approve travel and seminars for Titus County Employees and Elected Officials**

Carl Johnson informed the court that no travel had been turned in for approval. Judge Russell asked if there was anyone in the court that needed to have travel approved. There was none.

# Commissioners change medical insurance plan

In a fairly uneventful meeting on Monday, Titus County Commissioners' Court overwhelmingly approved naming Alliance-American National as its insurance carrier and minutes later voted to increase employee payment into the system by \$10 a month per dependent.

Titus County Judge Sam Russell was the lone member to oppose the increase, and noted that some employees have four dependents. At an additional \$40 a month, that could wipe out the five percent cost of living raise they were given earlier this year.

"For some, that would end up being more than their raise," Russell said. "I'm not sure we're really benefiting by it."

opping on \$10 a month for the dependents."

Precinct 1 Commissioner Bob Fitch, before making a motion to approve the item, said commissioners did not want to add to the burden on employees, but that the amounts had to be increased.

Titus County Sheriff Arvel Shepard echoed concerns over the increase, and noted it will affect his employees on the lower pay end.

Under the county's new coverage with Alliance-American National, employees will have direct access to the platinum East Texas Medical Center (ETMC) net-

work. That means employees will receive a deep discount - as much as 70 percent - if they visit an ETMC doctor, hospital or clinic.

Russell said he was concerned the move pitted ETMC against its competitor, Titus Regional Medical Center (TRMC).

TRMC is located in Mount Pleasant. ETMC is based in Tyler, but has hospitals in Pittsburg and Mount Vernon. Gail Norris, the county's insurance representative, said employees have the option of visiting ETMC for the greatest discount, or can visit any other hospital in the plan's outer networks,

which includes TRMC with a lesser discount.

Norris said employees could expect a 25 percent discount when visiting TRMC.

"We would love to have TRMC join the network," Norris said.

All changes become effective Jan. 1.

- Candidates Randy Becker, Gerald Hampton, Charles Wright, Alford Pleasant and the recently nominated Ezeal McGill will each receive roughly 181 votes.
