**As required by the Texas Family Code (TFC), 261,002. The Texas Department of Family and Protective Services maintains a Central Registry of reported cases of child abuse and neglect. The Child Protective Services Central Registry consists only of information gathered during investigations of child abuse and neglect in cases which were given a disposition of "reason to believe," and the person had a role of designated perpetrator or sustained perpetrator. The search is conducted on request and the results are provided to the requester (or their results are provided to the requester (or their designee)
