Re: Imposition of Optional Fees

Your Honor:

County commissioner's courts are statutorily required to notify the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) each year regarding the imposition or removal of optional fees. Notice must be made to the TxDMV by September 1 with the new fees taking effect on January 1. This letter and attachments will provide you information on how to submit Calendar Year 2015 notification to the TxDMV.

The following is a brief description of the local optional fees from Chapter 502 of the Transportation Code:

County Road and Bridge Fee (Section 502.401):

- may not exceed \$10;
- fees collected must be credited to the county road and bridge fund

Child Safety Fee (Section 502.403):

- not less than 50 cents or more than \$1.50;
- revenue must be used for school crossing guard services; remaining funds must be used for programs to enhance child safety, health, or nutrition, including child abuse intervention and prevention and drug and alcohol abuse prevention

Transportation Project Fee (Section 502.402) applies to Bexar, Cameron, El Paso, Hidalgo, and Webb counties only:

- may not exceed \$10 unless approved by majority of qualified voters in accordance with Texas Transportation Code 504.402 (b-1);
- revenue must be used for long-term transportation projects that are consistent with the purposes specified by Section 7-a, Article VIII, Texas Constitution

Please complete the attached form, Imposition of Optional Fees, and return it to the TxDMV. If your county will keep the same optional fees for calendar year 2015, complete OPTION A. If your county will change any fees, complete OPTION B and return the form with a scanned electronic copy of the Commissioners Court Order.

Collecting the Child Safety Fee

The Child Safety Fee¹ is an

- optional fee, not less than 50 cents or more than \$1.50 for registering a vehicle in the county
- · used to provide school crossing guard services.
 - Remaining funds are used for programs to enhance child safety, health, or nutrition, including child abuse intervention and prevention and drug and alcohol abuse prevention.

The Child Safety Fee: Your county's role

All county Commissioner's Courts are statutorily required to notify the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles each year regarding the collection of optional fees.² This fee may take effect only on January 1 of a year. The individual county must adopt an order mandating the fee and notify the Department no later than September 10 of the year preceding the year in which the fee will take effect.

Example 1: On February 15, 2012, County X decides it would like to collect the Child Safety Fee as soon as possible. The county Commissioner's Court adopt an order imposing the fee by September 10, 2012. The fee will go into effect on January 1, 2013.

Example 2: On February 15, 2012, County X decides it would like to collect the Child Safety Fee as soon as possible. The county Commissioner's Court adopt an order imposing the fee by September 15, 2012. The fee will go into effect on January 1, 2014.

After adopting an order mandating the collection of the child safety fee, the funds may then be used to pay for crossing guard services within the county. Any excess funds that remain may be used by the county for programs to enhance child safety, health or nutrition, including child abuse intervention and prevention. Distribution of excess funds to any qualifying programs is at the discretion of each county Commissioner's Court.
