
WHEREAS, due to inflation in the costs of living, and in order to confirm her salary to that of Official Court Reporters serving a similar population and with a like work load, the Court deems it necessary and appropriate that the salary should be increased \$100.00 a month or an increase of \$1,200.00 per year, making a salary of \$61,292.40 per year, or \$5107.70 per month, commencing on October 1, 2015 and to be apportioned among the four counties on a per monthly basis as follows:


