
- All District Courtrooms; (Courtroom A and B)
- Judges' Chambers;
- Jury room;
- District Clerk's Office
- Attorney Consultation rooms
- Restrooms (all of which are used by jurors, parties, witnesses, attorneys and judges);
- District Attorney's Office
- Jimmy L. White Law Library
- All staff offices, hallways and common areas outside the courtrooms and offices specifically mentioned herein.
- Any Courtroom used for Child Protection Services or Texas Department of Family and Protective Services
- Adult Probation Office –Titus County CSCD
- Juvenile Probation Office
- Court Reporters Office
- Meeting areas outside the Jimmy L. White Law Library

As part of these findings it is found that the hallways, common areas, stairwells, elevators and restrooms are all used by jurors, witnesses, parties, attorneys, prosecutors, officers of the court and judicial personnel as stated above. Use of these areas is integral and necessary to the operations of the courts.
