

Under Texas Transportation Code Chapter 252, Subchapter D, Section 252.301

(c) If the majority of the votes received in the election favor adoption, this subchapter takes effect in the county on the date the official result of the election is determined.

This means that the change goes into effect when we canvass the election later this week. As it will take a few weeks to hire a County Road Engineer I propose that in the interim, until the Road Engineer is in place:

1. Commissioners continue to supervise their road crews on a day to day basis.
2. No new road hands are hired.
3. No road crew employee receives changes to their pay or benefits, except for county wide benefit changes.
4. No new or used vehicles or other road equipment is purchased or sold.
5. Vehicle and equipment maintenance is kept to normal schedules.
