1. HEALTH INSURANCE WORKSHOP WITH HIGGINBOTHAM

2. CONSIDER AND POSSIBLY APPROVE ANY CHANGES TO COUNTY HEALTH INSURANCE

- **A.** Motion was made by Commissioner Parker and seconded by Commissioner Applewhite to increase **Prescription Drugs 30 day Supply** as follows:
 - Generic \$15
 - Brand Name \$50
 - Non Preferred Brand \$100
 - Specialty \$300

Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.

- **B.** Motion was made by Commissioner Parker and seconded by Commissioner Fields to become part of the **Premium PDL Plan**. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.
- **C.** Motion was made by Commissioner Fields and seconded by Commissioner Applewhite to join the **Real Appeal Program**. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting. (SEE ATTACHMENT 01)
- D. Motion was made by Commissioner Applewhite and seconded by Commissioner Parker to implement the On-Line Benefits Enrollment System and Cobra Administration to Higginbotham beginning 02/01/2018. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.
- **E.** Motion was made by Commissioner Parker and seconded by Commissioner Applewhite to go with the **Dual Option Plan**. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.
- **F.** Motion was made by Commissioner Fields and seconded by Judge Lee to approve the **Annual Deductible** as shown on attached chart. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting. (SEE ATTACHMENT 01)
- **G.** Motion was made by Commissioner Fields and seconded by Judge Lee to approve maintaining the same **Annual Maximum Out of Pocket** as shown on attached chart. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting. (SEE ATTACHMENT 01)
- **H.** Motion was made by Commissioner Fields to change **Coinsurance** to 80% on the individual New Base Plan. Motion died due to lack of second.

- I. Motion was made by Commissioner Fields and seconded by Commissioner Applewhite to change **Office Visit Copay** to \$30 on the **New Base Plan**. Motion passed three to one with Judge Lee voting nay and Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.
- J. Motion was made by Commissioner Fields and seconded by Judge Lee to make **Teledoc** zero costs for employees regardless of which plan is chosen. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.
- **K.** There is no change in **Urgent Care**.
- L. Motion was made by Commissioner Parker and seconded by Judge Lee to change Non True Emergency determined to 70% after deductible. Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.
- M. Motion was made by Commissioner Fields and seconded by Judge Lee to approve the following rates for Base Plan per Employee Semi Monthly Payroll Deduction:
 - Employee Only \$0.00
 - Employee Children \$150.00
 - Employee Spouse \$187.50
 - Employee Family \$262.50

Motion passed four to zero with Commissioner Riddle abstaining from voting.
