

The Talco Cemetery is a large cemetery located in the town of Talco, Texas in Titus County. In 1912 the now town of Talco was relocated from its original site of Goulsboro designating land for the Talco Cemetery.

First deed to the cemetery is found in Volume 36, Page 190, dated 3-10-1915. The second deed is found in Volume 311, page 99 donated by Leora Cloar Stevenson dated 6-10-1965. The third deed is found in Volume 766, Page 275, dated 5-2-1993 donated by James Oral Geiger, Jr, etal.

The current Talco Cemetery Association was established June 14, 2014, with articles of Association and Constitution and By Laws dated March 21, 2015.

Current activities include monthly or quarterly meeting with officers, trustees and community members. Twice a year community involved clean ups and fund raisers are held. Maintenance includes leveling of grave depressions, gravestone repairs, mowing, tree trimming, fence repairs and road repairs.
