



WHEREAS, due to inflation in the costs of living, and in order to confirm her salary to that of Official Court Reporters serving a similar population and with a like work load, the Court deems it necessary and appropriate that the salary should be increased \$106.28 a month or an increase of \$1,275.36 per year, making a salary of \$65,043.96 per year, or \$5,420.33 per month, commencing on October 1, 2018 and to be apportioned among the three counties on a per monthly basis as follows:

CAMP COUNTY ..... \$ 1,246.68  
MORRIS COUNTY ..... \$ 1,300.88  
TITUS COUNTY ..... \$ 2,872.77
