Yes the Executive Committee looked at Republican Primary voters in Nevills Chapel and saw a majority voted early. We have combined that box in the past by bringing Pct 8 into 15. This time we thought folks come into town easier than going in reverse.

The increased numbers in early voting was also the reasoning behind combining Pct. 3, 16 & 17 into the Civic Ctr. Pcts 1, 18 & 14 into the Courthouse Annex. Pcts 11 & 12 into Winfield School. We are keeping the remote Precincts open and combining the precincts in town or close to it.

As a side note, the law asks me to earnestly search for people living in a Precinct to serve in that Precinct for election day. I do have someone willing to be a Presiding Judge in 15, but finding 2 more clerks is nearly impossible. If folks would like to help in that regard, I'd love to hear from them.

You can have people call me for questions. The Republican Party runs their own election and we'd like to have more people learn the process, and the purpose of a Primary. All the polls will be open in November. Some might want to wait until then. LOL
