DECLARATION OF A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Titus, beginning February 11, 2021, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or threat of loss of life or property resulting from:

Extreme winter weather including heavy snow, prolonged freezing temperatures, utility Outages, deterioration of roads, excessive flooding; and

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Titus County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the hardship of people and to protect, including but not limited to the rehabilitation of property (private and governmental), the impact on non-profit/private businesses, agriculture, rural/urban water utilities, school districts, emergency services, road/streets/highways/bridges; and

WHEREAS, Titus County is requesting public assistance in meeting the needs of the above-mentioned damages as a result of the winter weather event;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF TITUS:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Titus County, Texas.

Pursuant to 418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this state of disaster shall continue immediately and indefinitely by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Titus as shown below;

Pursuant to 418.018 of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Titus County Clerk.

Pursuant to 418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Titus County Emergency Management Plan.
