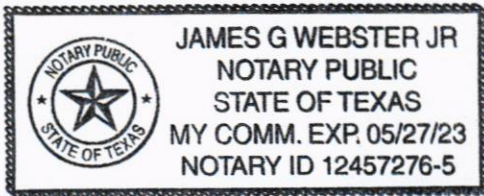

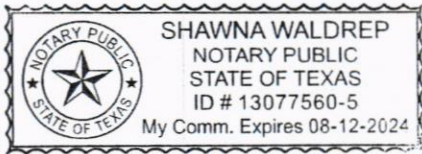

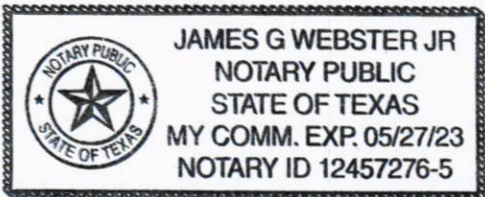
ANNUAL ROAD REPORT
