RECOGNITION OF DISCRETIONARY EXEMPTIONS FOR COMPETITIVE BIDDING

Section 262.023 of the Local Government Code requires competitive bidding for certain purchases that will require an expenditure exceeding \$ 50,000.

Section 262.024a of the Local Government Code lists discretionary exemptions that may be followed if approved by commissioners' court. In summary, these items are:

- 1) Purchases in the case of public calamity,
- 2) Purchases to protect public health or public safety,
- 3) Purchases necessary due to unforeseen damage to public property,
- 4) Personal or professional service,
- 5) Individual work perform and paid for by the day,
- 6) Any land or right-of way,
- 7) An item that can be obtained only from one source such as:
 - A. Existence of patents, copyrights, secret process, or monopolies;
 - B. Films, manuscripts, or books;
 - C. Electric power, gas, water and other utility services;
 - D. Captive replacement parts or components for equipment,
- 8) An item of food.
- 9) Personal property sold:
 - A. At an auction by a state licensed auctioneer;
 - B. At a going out of business sale
 - C. By a political subdivision of this state, state agency or federal government,
- 10) Work performed under a contract for community and economic development,
- 11) Vehicle and equipment repairs.

The above listing of discretionary exemptions is summarized. Please see the local government code for additional details.

Section 262,024c of the Local Government Code directs that the official who makes purchases for the county submit a signed statement to commissioners' court for such items. Further, this approval must be entered in the minutes. Please see the signed statement attached.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SOLE SOURCE AFFIDAVIT

Vendors who meet the requirements below for sole source purchasing must complete this form in its entirety, have it notarized and emailed to the Titus County Auditor's Office – auditor@co.titus.tx.us before any purchase will be authorized. Sole source affidavits will be valid for one year from the date notarized.

<u>Sole Source Requirements:</u> A sole source purchase can be made without the benefit of a competitive purchasing process when there are no other items available in the marketplace that have the same <u>fit</u>, <u>form and function</u> of the items being purchased. To meet this definition, the vendor must satisfy one of the following requirements:

- A) An item for which competition is precluded because of the existence of a patent, copyright, secret process, or monopoly;
- B) A film, manuscript or book;
- C) A utility service, including electricity, gas, or water, and
- D) A captive replacement part or component for equipment.
