Fire Station Approximately 9,300 sq. ft. @ \$400 per sq. ft.=\$3,720,000 (this is estimated on it being built inside the city limits to meet the codes)

Furnishings for station \$35,000

Air compressor to fill self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) \$48,000

Annual air test for SCBA air compressor \$2,500

Structural firefighting personal protective equipment (PPE) -2 sets for each ff @ \$5,000 per set=\$120,000 (based on 13 personnel)

Structure PPE washer-\$10,000

Station uniforms-13 @ \$500 each=\$6,500

Wildland firefighting personal protective equipment (PPE)-13 sets @ \$1,000 each=\$13,000

Fire Engine \$800,000 includes all the equipment except vehicle extrication tools

Vehicle extrication tools-\$46,000

Fire Engine, reserve \$200,000

Brush trucks-2 @ \$200,000 each =\$400,000

Fire chief's truck \$70,000

Radio repeater for new county FD channel \$60,000 (6-8 months to get license for new channel)

Renting tower space to put radio repeater on \$800-\$1000 per month

Building tower if tower space is unavailable, \$300,000

Reprograming 111 portable/mobile radios @ \$30 each=\$3,330

Cost of land to build station on if county doesn't have property ????

## **OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER**

- MPFD has 33 firefighters currently, not including the Fire Chief and administrative assistant. Minimum staffing is 10. That allows us to send 6 on-duty personnel, not including the Fire Chief and administrative assistant, to incidents in the county. If additional manpower is needed, there are 22 off duty firefighters that could be recalled for duty.
- Once the goal of 45 firefighters is reached, the minimum staffing will be 13 which will allow MPFD to send
  9 firefighters to incidents in the county. i.e. Structure fire 2-four man engine companies and a Deputy
  Chief at a minimum. The Fire Chief and administrative assistant may also respond and serve Incident
  Command roles. If additional manpower is needed there will be 30 off duty firefighters that could be
  recalled for duty.
- There is extreme value in having well trained and experienced personnel. This is not something you can put a price tag on or buy. As shown below, MPFD personnel have a combined years of experience of 488 years. Our Command Staff averages 28 years of service and the rank and file averages 9 years, with many having more than 20 years on the job. All of our personnel are well trained.
- A county fire department with a total of 13 personnel, including the chief, would only have 4 people on
  duty and the Fire Chief on weekdays during the day. If additional manpower is needed there are only 8 off
  duty that could be recalled.

If they plan on keeping the minimum staffing of 4 on duty, then any time someone takes off overtime will
have to paid to whoever covers the shift. This will result in a several thousand dollars of overtime. The
alternative is to operate with less than 4 firefighters on duty.
