Market Modification petition for Titus County, Texas

History of how counties are assigned TV stations – "significantly viewed status"

This is part of the STELAR bill which became law in 2014 (Satellite Television Extension and Localism Act of 2014)

Outlines the process for counties, cities, municipalities, broadcasters, satellite operators to petition the FCC for "Orphaned Status" meaning the FCC authorizes the satellite providers in the county to start carrying TV stations signals from the same state as the county location.

It does not remove any signals, it just adds signals


The petition process is based on 5 criteria

- Whether the station or other stations located in the same area have been historically
 - <u>carried</u> on: (a) the cable system or systems within that community; and (b) <u>the</u> satellite
 - carrier or carriers serving that community;
- Whether the television station provides coverage or other local service to that community.
- Whether modifying the local market of the television station would promote consumers' access to television broadcast station signals that originate in their state of residence.
- Whether any other television station that is eligible to be carried by a satellite carrier in
 - the community in fulfillment of the requirements **provides news coverage** of issues of
 - concern to the community or provides carriage or coverage of sporting and other events
 - of interest to the community.
- **Evidence of viewing patterns** in households that subscribe and do not subscribe to the
 - services offered by multichannel video programming distributors within the areas served by the multichannel video programming distributors in the community

Once the petition is sent to the FCC, the commission has 120 days to review and either grant or deny the petition.


If granted, the station(s) request carriage from the satellite carrier and carriage and once an agreement is achieved carriage must begin within 90 days.


Digital Broadcast Signal Map





