I was thinking we would just do a 3-way organizational split and me and you could work the split out within (the County commissioners are one that tower too). We received 3 bids and the lowest was for \$9,625. We have used the company for other work and they could get the generator installed this week (in fact, they are out today doing the install). I didn't want to wait since it was the emergency power for our radio system up there.

With that, the split would be \$3,208 for the city, county and hospital. I started an email to Monica Walden to notify her, but never sent it because there was confusion if one of the school districts was using the tower (they are not using this tower, just the water tower). I can still send that to her if you would like.

Thanks for getting back to me. Sorry for the last minute notice but I thought the generator was good until we were doing our quarterly inspection and the generator was blowing smoke. The city mechanics said the motor is bad and recommended replacing it. I went with their recommendation, not feeling like I should be waiting on this type of equipment.

The north radio tower generator has given up the ghost. I have our facilities folks getting quotes for a replacement, but we are estimating probably \$10,000 or more. As we all share use of the tower and building for our radio systems, I would like you to be willing to contribute to the cost of the new generator and any needed repairs costs in the future. Two years ago I replaced one of the building's air conditioners when it died, but these are not costs I have budgeted. The only reason I didn't do the other air conditioner at the time was due to funding (it was recommended to do both at the time). I am not aware of any written agreements on the tower, except with Verizon who built it, but I believe it is fair to share repair costs when they are needed. Please let me know if you are willing to split this cost.
